FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
EP ENERGY E&P COMPANY, L.P.
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
UNIVERSITY EAST 43-24 CENTRAL PRODUCTION FACILITY
UNIVERSITY EAST LEASE
LIN (WOLFCAMP) FIELD
CROCKETT COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 20, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that EP Energy E&P Company, LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the University East 43-24 Central Production Facility, University East Lease, Lin (Wolfcamp) Field, Crockett County, Texas. EP Energy E&P Company, LP is authorized to flare up to 2000 MCF per day of casing-head gas from the University East 43-24 Central Production Facility from April 28, 2014 through April 28, 2016. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
