**FINAL ORDER  
APPLICATION OF BP AMERICA PROD. CO.  
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 28  
SEMI-ANNUAL G-10 TESTS  
CARTHAGE (HAYNESVILLE SHALE) FIELD  
SHELBY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 21, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of BP America Production. Co., for exception to Statewide Rule 28 requiring semi-annual G-10 well tests, is hereby **GRANTED** for all gas wells in the Carthage (Haynesville Shale) Field. No G-10 deliverability test shall be required in the Carthage (Haynesville Shale) Field while the allocation formula is suspended. Upon reinstatement of the allocation formula, the G-10 deliverability testing for the Carthage (Haynesville Shale) Field shall be performed annually from October to December.

All other requirements of Statewide Rule 28 shall remain in effect.
