**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
LINN OPERATING, INC.
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
FOR THE ALLAR I LEASE
SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELD
MARTIN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 18 and August 26, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that LINN Operating, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Allar I Lease (Lease ID No. 08-39566), Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, Martin County, Texas. LINN Operating, Inc. is authorized to flare up to 2,000 MCF per day of casinghead gas from the Allar I Lease beginning May 29, 2014 and ending on May 29, 2015. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
