FINAL ORDER

THE APPLICATION OF PARALLEL PETROLEUM, LLC
TO CONSIDER A FIELD WIDE MAXIMUM EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE FOR THE
HARRIS (SAN ANDRES) FIELD, GAINES COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 22, 2015, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all oil wells in the Harris (San Andres) Field, Gaines County, Texas may be produced under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 550 BOPD.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction in the Harris (San Andres) Field is hereby cancelled.
