**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF XTO ENERGY, INC.  
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO SEMI-ANNUAL G-10 WELL TESTS  
PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 28  
AND TO AMEND FIELD RULES  
OPELIKA (COTTON VALLEY) FIELD  
HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket hearing on May 14, 2015 the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained herein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of XTO Energy Inc, to amend field rules to allow an exception to Statewide Rule 28 requiring semi-annual G-10 testing is hereby **GRANTED** for all wells in the Opelika (Cotton Valley) Field. All wells that produce more than 100 MCFPD in the Opelika (Cotton Valley) Field will require annual G-10 testing and the filing of Form G-10 once per year. Wells that produce less than 100 MCFPD are exempt from all Statewide Rule 28 G-10 testing requirements.

All other requirements of Statewide Rule 28 shall remain in effect.
