**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
COG OPERATING, LLC FOR AN EXTENSION OF FLARING PERMIT,  
EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32, FOR THE  
LUDEMAN A BATTERY AND LUDEMAN BATTERY WELLS,  
TWO GEORGES (BONE SPRINGS) FIELD, LOVING COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 17, 2015, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that COG Operating, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Ludeman A Battery and the Ludeman Battery Wells in the Two Georges (Bone Springs) Field, Loving County, Texas. COG Operating, LLC is authorized to flare up to 1,000 MCF of gas per day from the Ludeman A Battery from September 9, 2015, through September 9, 2016, and to flare up to 1,000 MCF of gas per day from the Ludeman Battery from July 31, 2015, through July 31, 2016. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
