FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
CALAMITY JANE AND DEACON JIM 16 LEASES
WOLFBONE (TREND AREA) FIELD
REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 17, 2015, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rosetta Resources Operating LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Calamity Jane and Deacon Jim 16 Leases, being located in Reeves County, Texas. Rosetta Resources Operating LP is authorized to flare a total of up to 10,000 MCFG per day from the Calamity Jane Lease (Permit No. 20802), effective October 15, 2015 through October 15, 2017, and up to 2,000 MCFG per day from the Deacon Jim 16 Lease (Permit No. 21935), effective December 1, 2015 through December 1, 2017. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
