NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FORT APACHE ENERGY, INC. FOR AN
EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR NORDIN LEASE, WELL NO. 1,
WILDCAT FIELD, TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

At conference on November 05, 2015, the Commission voted to approve the referenced docket. Due to clerical error, the final order incorrectly stated that Fort Apache Energy, Inc. is authorized to flare a cumulative total of up to 150 MCFD of casinghead gas from August 01, 2015 through August 01, 2017 from its **Augusta Barrow** Lease in Ector County, Texas, Final Order is hereby amended, ***nunc pro tunc***, to correct the error. The corrected order reads as follows:

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas Fort Apache Energy, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for its **Nordin Lease**, Well No. 1, Wildcat Field, Tyler County, Texas. Fort Apache is authorized to flare a cumulative total of up to 150 MCFD of casinghead gas from August 01, 2015 through August 01, 2017 from its Nordin Lease, Well No. 1, Wildcat Field, Tyler County, Texas.

The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet for the Nordin Lease and shall file, at the same time the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
