SUSPENSION ORDER

Notice of Open Meeting to consider this Order was duly posted with the Secretary of State within the time provided by law pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. Chapter 551.

On March 30, 2016, Texas Gas Service Company ("TGS") filed with the Railroad Commission a "Statement of Intent" to increase gas utility rates within the unincorporated areas of the El Paso Service Area ("EPSA"), Permian Service Area ("PSA"), and Dell City Service Area ("DCSA").

The Commission has the authority to suspend the proposed rates for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days from the date on which the rates otherwise would become effective, under TEX. UTIL. CODE ANN. § 104.107(a)(2). The Commission requires further time to consider the propriety of the proposed rate change. A Commission order is necessary to suspend the operation of the proposed rate schedules for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days from the date on which the schedules would otherwise become effective.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS that the date on which TGS's proposed rate change would become effective, as detailed in its Statement of Intent, is hereby **SUSPENDED** for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days.
