**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF OXY USA, INC.
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32, FOR THE
BRUNSON INGRAM LEASE, WELL NO. 1823R, THE TOM A LEASE, WELL NO. 1,
AND THE WEYMAN A LEASE, WELL NOS. 1544 AND 1533**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 29, 2015, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that OXY USA, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Brunson Ingram Lease, Well No. 1823R, the Tom A Lease, Well No. 1, and the Weyman A Lease, Well Nos. 1544 and 1533 in the Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, Glasscock County, Texas. OXY USA, Inc. is authorized to flare up to 250 MCF of gas per day from the Brunson Ingram Lease, Well No.1823R from October 6, 2015, through July 31, 2016; up to 200 MCF of gas per day from the Tom A Lease, Well No.1 from October 6, 2015, through July 31, 2016; and up to 150 MCF of gas per day from the Weyman A Lease, Well Nos. 1544 and 1533 from October 6, 2015, through July 31, 2016. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
