**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
PATRIOT RESOURCES, INC.  
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32  
NYALA UNIT 9A, 9B; DARLINGTON UNIT 11A; AND  
AFRICAN LION TANK BATTERIES  
WOLFBONE (TREND AREA) FIELD  
REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on April 13, 2016, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Patriot Resources, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Nyala Unit 9A, 9B Battery (Flare Permit No. 25585), Darlington Unit 11A Battery (Flare Permit No. 25584), and African Lion Battery (Lease ID No. 46349), being located in the Wolfbone (Trend Area) Field, Reeves County, Texas. Patriot Resources, Inc. is authorized to flare up to the maximum volumes of casing-head gas for the time period specified, as listed on Attachment "A" and incorporated herein. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
