The Appeal is hereby **GRANTED**.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that the Administrative Law Judge shall amend and supplement the Protective Order as follows:

- 1. Amend Protective Order Paragraph 7(c); "independent experts or consultants (together with their staff and others hired by the experts or consultants for purposes of this docket) retained by counsel in this docket who, prior to any disclosure of Classified Information to such person, have signed a document agreeing to be bound by the terms of this Protective Order (such signed document to be maintained by the attorney retaining such person) and have been designated in writing by notice to all counsel;"
- 2. Supplement Protective Order with the addition of Paragraph 13; "Each party's counsel shall maintain a log of all copies of For Counsel Only documents that are delivered to Qualified Persons."
- 3. Supplement Protective Order with the addition of Paragraph 14; "Any party designating any person as a Qualified Person shall have the duty to reasonably ensure that such person observes the terms of this Protective Order and shall be responsible upon breach of such duty for the failure of such person to observe the terms of this Protective Order."

It is further **ORDERED** that the Administrative Law Judge shall reissue the amended and supplemented Protective Order.
