DEWITT (EAGLE FORD SHALE) FIELD,
DE WITT COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on October 19, 2016, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Devon Energy Production Co is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 to flare casinghead gas from a single flare point for the Sheppard A Lease, Well No. 1H, DeWitt (Eagle Ford Shale) Field, De Witt County, Texas. Devon Energy Production Co is authorized to flare up to 125 MCF per day of casinghead gas for a period of two years, effective September 8, 2016. The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

Devon Energy Production Co shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
