FINAL ORDER

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF MID-CON ENERGY OPERATING, LLC,
TO CONSIDER A FIELD-WIDE MAXIMUM EFFICIENT RATE (MER) ALLOWABLE
AND TO CANCEL ALL ACCRUED OVERAGE FOR THE HARDROCK (KING SAND)
FIELD, NOLAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket regarding the application submitted by Mid-Con Energy Operating, LLC and heard on October 26, 2016, the presiding Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Mid-Con Energy Operating, LLC is hereby granted permission to produce all wells in the Hardrock (King Sand) Field, Nolan County, Texas, at a maximum efficiency rate (MER) of 130 BOPD.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all accumulated overproduction for all wells in the Hardrock (King Sand) Field, Nolan County, Texas, is hereby cancelled.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that this order shall be final and effective on the date the Commission's order is signed.
