In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on September 12, 2016, the matter granting Riley Exploration OPG Co., LLC an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Cleveland A 601 Battery, Well Nos. 1H and 4H, and Double Down 602-643 Battery, Well Nos. 2XH and 4XH, Platang (San Andres) Field, Yoakum County, Texas. The Commission finds that, due to typographical errors, the Final Order entered September 12, 2016 stated multiple inconsistencies.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 8A-0300103 be, and the same is hereby, amended nunc pro tunc so that the order contains the correct docket number, well names and tank batteries associated with 8A-0300103.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Riley Exploration OPG Co, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Cleveland A 601 Battery, Well Nos. 1H and 4H (Lease ID No. 8A-70404), and the and Double Down 602-643 Battery, Well Nos. 2XH and 4XH (Lease ID No. 8A-70446), being located in the Platang (San Andres) Field, Yoakum County, Texas Riley Exploration OPG Co, LLC is authorized to flare up to a cumulative volume of 2,000 MCF per day of casing-head gas for a period of one year, effective April 29, 2016. This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
