FINAL ORDER

APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CABOT OIL & GAS CORPORATION FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE SPEAR POINT LEASE, WELL NO. 1H, BRISCOE RANCH (EAGLEFORD) FIELD, FRIO COUNTY, TEXAS.

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on December 21, 2016, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application submitted by Cabot Oil & Gas Corporation is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Cabot Oil & Gas Corporation is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Briscoe Ranch (EagleFord) Field, Frio County, Texas. Cabot is authorized to flare a maximum volume of 180 MCF per day of casinghead gas from the Spear Point Lease, Well No. 1H, from December 3, 2016 through December 2, 2017.

The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. Murphy Exploration & Production Company shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
