**FINAL ORDER
GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF ENERVEST OPERATING, LLC
PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 101
FOR THE DESIGNATION OF THE MILLS RANCH (GRANITE WASH CONS.) FIELD
AS A TIGHT GAS FORMATION,
WHEELER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 30, 2015, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of EnerVest Operating, LLC for a tight formation area designation for that portion of the Mills Ranch (Granite Wash Cons.) Field, in Wheeler County, Texas, described below, is hereby **GRANTED**.

The designated tight formation area includes that portion of the Mills Ranch (Granite Wash Cons.) Field that consists of the Kansas City Formation, B and C intervals, in the following eleven surveys containing a total of 6,422 acres, as shown on the attached area map:

- Section 50 Block A3 H&GN RR Co./Young, A. H. Survey, A-8461;
- Section 49 Block A3 H&GN RR Co. Survey, A-219;

- Section 9 Block A3 H&GN RR Co. Survey, A-199.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Commission that this order shall not be final and effective until 25 days after the Commission's order is signed, unless the time for filing a motion for rehearing has been extended under Tex. Gov't Code §2001.142, by agreement under Tex. Gov't Code §2001.147, or by written Commission Order issued pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §2001.146(e). If a timely motion for rehearing of an application is filed by any party at interest, this order shall not become final and effective until such motion is overruled, or if such motion is granted, this order shall be subject to further action by the Commission. Pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §2001.146(e), the time allotted for Commission action on a motion for rehearing in this case prior to its being overruled by operation of law is hereby extended until 90 days from the date Commission Order is signed.
