
This was a Commission called hearing under the authorization of Article 6005 to determine the responsibility for properly plugging the Mark Oil Company G. W. Culver well No. 3, in the East Texas Field.

The subject well was a deviated well, on which action was taken by the Attorney General's Department, and according to Commission records, the well has not yet been plugged.

Formal notice to the operator, under Rule 14b, was duly issued by the District Office, without results. Certified mail notice of this hearing was returned undelivered.

In order to clear the file for appropriate future action, in case the operator remains unlocatable, it is the recommendation of the writer that order be issued to Mark Oil Company, as operator, to plug the subject well.


