**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
KINDER MORGAN PRODUCTION CO LLC
FOR INJECTION OF FLUIDS CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE,
BERGEN (70250) LEASE, WELL NO. I21,
TALL COTTON (SAN ANDRES) FIELD, GAINES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 16, 2017, the presiding Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Kinder Morgan Production Co LLC is hereby authorized to inject fluids containing hydrogen sulfide into the Bergen (70250) Lease, Well No. I21, (Project No. F-19864, UIC No. 000110814), Tall Cotton (San Andres) Field, Gaines County, Texas, pursuant to Statewide Rule 36(c)(10)(A).

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
