FINAL ORDER

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF RILEY EXPLORATION OPG CO., LLC, FOR
AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 TO FLARE GAS FROM THE WESTERN
SKIES 600-645 LEASE, WELL NOS. 1XH AND 2XH, PLATANG (SAN ANDRES)
FIELD, YOAKUM COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on May 18, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application submitted by Riley Exploration OPG CO., LLC is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Riley Exploration OPG CO., LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Western Skies 600-645 Lease, Well Nos. 1XH and 2XH, for a period of one year at a volume of 2,000 mcf/d of casinghead gas from 03/10/2017 through 03/10/2018.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the well.
