**FINAL ORDER
GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF BOPCO, LP
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR 13 FLARE POINTS IN THE
KEYSTONE HOLT UNIT, KEYSTONE (CONSOLIDATED) FIELD,
WINKLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 1, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that BOPCO, LP is hereby authorized to flare gas from the Keystone Holt Unit in the Keystone (Consolidated) Field, Winkler County, Texas subject to the limits set out below:
