**FINAL ORDER
GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF HADAWAY CONS & ENGINEERING LLC
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
FOR THE YADA YADA 420 LEASE (70490), WELL NO. 3H,
AND THE DEL BOCA VISTA 372 LEASE (70526), WELL NO. 5H,
PLATANG (SAN ANDRES) FIELD,
YOAKUM COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 7, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Hadaway Cons & Engineering LLC is hereby granted authority to flare gas from the following facilities in the Platang (San Andres) Field, Yoakum County, Texas:

- Hadaway Cons & Engineering LLC may flare up to 350 thousand cubic feet of gas per day from the Yada Yada 420 Lease (No. 70490) Well No. 3H, from April 5, 2017 through April 4, 2019 (Flare Permit No. 29431).
- Hadaway Cons & Engineering LLC may flare up to 70 thousand cubic feet of gas from the Del Boca Vista 372 Lease (No. 70526) Well No. 5H, from June 14, 2017 through June 13, 2019 (Flare Permit No. 29482).

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the facility.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
