



State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Wells Plugged June 2017





State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Cost of Wells Plugged June 2017



State-funded Well Plugging Program Cumulative Wells Plugged June 2017




State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Salvage Operations June 2017




