## **FINAL ORDER**

GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF EP ENERGY E&P COMPANY, LP FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR FLARE GAS PERMIT FOR VARIOUS CENTRAL PRODUCTION FACILITIES, BLOCK 39-B (ELLEN), LIN (WOLFCAMP), SAWYER (LEONARD) AND SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELDS, CROCKETT COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 17, 2017, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that EP Energy E&P Company, LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the following four Central Production Facilities in the Block 39-B (Ellen), Lin (Wolfcamp), Sawyer (Leonard) and Spraberry (Trend Area) Fields, Crockett County, Texas:
