**FINAL ORDER  
GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY  
TO CANCEL OVERPRODUCTION  
FOR THE LARRY DON AND JOYCE SMITH 70 LEASE (NO. 09495),  
PAN PETRO (MARMATON) FIELD,  
OCHILTREE COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 3, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.
