## **FINAL ORDER**

APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CABOT OIL & GAS CORPORATION FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 10 TO DOWNHOLE COMMINGLE IN THE BRISCOE RANCH (EAGLEFORD), THE AMMANN (BUDA), AND THE LORENZO (AUSTIN CHALK) FIELDS
IN ATASCOSA, DIMMIT, FRIO, LA SALLE, MAVERICK, MCMULLEN, WEBB, AND ZAVALA COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 29, 2017, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge ("Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law for which service was not required; that the proposed applications are in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein incorporates said Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Cabot Oil & Gas Corporation for an exception to Statewide Rule 10 for the Briscoe Ranch (Eagleford), the Ammann (Buda), and the Lorenzo (Austin Chalk) Fields in Atascosa, Dimmit, Frio, La Salle, Maverick, McMullen, Webb, and Zavala Counties, Texas, is hereby approved.

The operator of any well downhole commingled pursuant to this Final Order shall file the appropriate drilling permit, completion forms, and abbreviated Statewide Rule 10 Data Sheet and shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 10 exception downhole commingling fee.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
