FINAL ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF STEWARD ENERGY II, LLC FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR FLARE PERMIT FOR VARIOUS LEASES/WELLS, PLATANG (SAN ANDRES) FIELD, YOAKUM COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 16, 2017, the presiding Administrative Law Judge and Technical Examiner (collectively, "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Steward Energy II, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the ten flare points listed in Table I below. Steward Energy II, LLC is authorized to flare up to the maximum MCF of casinghead gas per day as listed for the ten flare points in Table I below, from August 30, 2017 through August 30, 2019.
