THE APPLICATION OF GULFTEX ENERGY IV, LP FOR AN EXCEPTION TO 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §3.32 FOR THE MADELON BATTERY, WELL NO. 1H, SUGARKANE (AUSTIN CHALK) FIELD, KARNES COUNTY, TEXAS

ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on December 5, 2017, the matter granting GulfTex Energy IV, LP an exception to Statewide Rule 32 to flare casing head from a single flare point for the Madelon Battery, in Karnes County, Texas. The Commission finds that, due to a typographical error, the Final Order entered on December 5, 2017, incorrectly stated the battery as the Augusta Barrow Lease, instead of the Madelon Battery.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 02-0305963 be, and the same is hereby, amended nunc pro tunc so that the order contains the correct battery name and the order now reads as follows:

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that GulfTex Energy IV, LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 (Permit No. 28950) for the Madelon Unit Well No. 1H, in the Sugarkane (Austin Chalk) Field, Karnes County, Texas. GulfTex Energy IV, LP is authorized to flare up to 250 thousand cubic feet of casinghead gas per day from August 12, 2017, through August 12, 2019. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet for the Madelon Battery and shall file, at the same time the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
