**APPLICATION OF ROSETTA RESOURCES OPERATING, LP FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE
RULE 32 FOR THE CALAMITY JANE (45695) LEASE, THE DEACON JIM 16 (45826) LEASE, AND
BLACK JACK 16 (45553) LEASE, WOLFBONE (TREND AREA) FIELD, REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 6, 2018, the technical examiner and administrative law judge (“Examiners”) have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rosetta Resources Operating, LP is hereby **GRANTED** authority to flare gas from the Calamity Jane, Deacon Jim 16, and Black Jack 16 Leases in the Wolfbone (Trend Area) Field, Reeves County, Texas, as follows:

- Calamity Jane Lease (No. 45695): Rosetta Resources Operating LP may flare up to 50,000 thousand cubic feet (“mcf”) per month from October 16, 2017 through October 15, 2019.
- Deacon Jim 16 Lease (No. 45826): Rosetta Resources Operating LP may flare up to 2,000 mcf per month from December 2, 2017 through December 1, 2019.
- Black Jack 16 Lease (No. 45553): Rosetta Resources Operating LP may flare up to 10,000 mcf per month from February 11, 2018 through February 10, 2020.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the facility.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
