O&G 03-0297521: ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST DENVER ENERGY EXPLORATION, LLC FOR VIOLATIONS OF STATEWIDE RULES ON THE DENVER KARBER (PERMIT NO. 720080) LEASE, WELL NO. 1, BROOKSHIRE FIELD, WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS; THE DENVER KARBER (PERMIT NO. 728445) LEASE, WELL NO. 2, BROOKSHIRE FIELD, WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS; AND THE TK3M (PERMIT NO. 745589) LEASE, WELL NO. 1, BROOKSHIRE FIELD, WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS.

ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on April 4, 2017 and Motion for Rehearing on April 27, 2017, an Enforcement Action Against Denver Energy Exploration, LLC for Violations of Statewide Rules on The Denver Karber (Permit No. 720080) Lease, Well No. 1, Brookshire Field, Waller County, Texas; The Denver Karber (Permit No. 728445) Lease, Well No. 2, Brookshire Field, Waller County, Texas; and the TK3M (Permit No. 745589) Lease, Well No. 1, Brookshire Field, Waller County, Texas.. The Commission finds that the Final Order entered April 4, 2017, erroneously identified the permit number of The Denver Karber (Permit No. 728445) Lease, Well No. 2, Brookshire Field, Waller County, Texas. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Oil and Gas Docket No. 03-0297521 and the Motion for Rehearing denied on April 27, 2017 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the Final Order correctly states the above-corrected permit number.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.
