Attached is the monthly report titled "State-funded Well Plugging Activities" for the Field Operations Section of the Oil and Gas Division. This report contains the following:

- 2. Summary graphs of wells plugged, cost of wells plugged, number of salvage operations, and salvage proceeds.
- 3. A list of state-funded plugging contracts in excess of \$100,000 where the original encumbered amount has been exceeded by 10% or more. The contracts will be carried on this report until completed.

The information contained in this report includes only those wells that have been physically plugged, invoiced by the plugging contractor, and approved for payment by Field Operations. Plugging operations are tracked daily to monitor the progress in meeting the FY 2018 goal of plugging 1,500 wells. As of April 30, 2018, a total of 885 wells have been physically plugged, though not all of them have yet been invoiced and approved for payment.

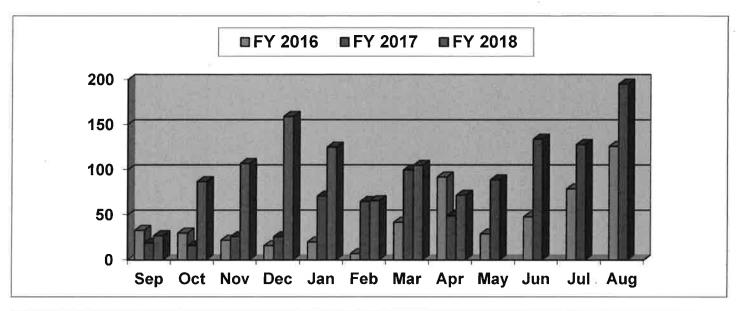

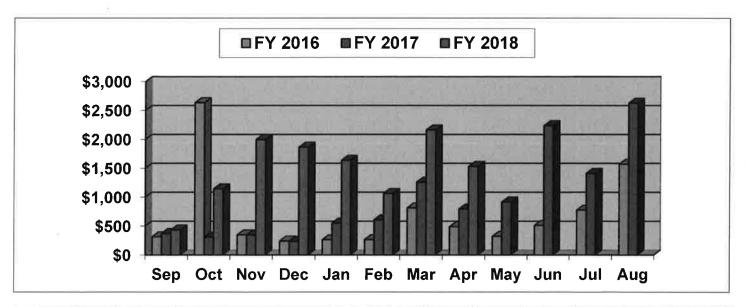

State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Wells Plugged April 2018



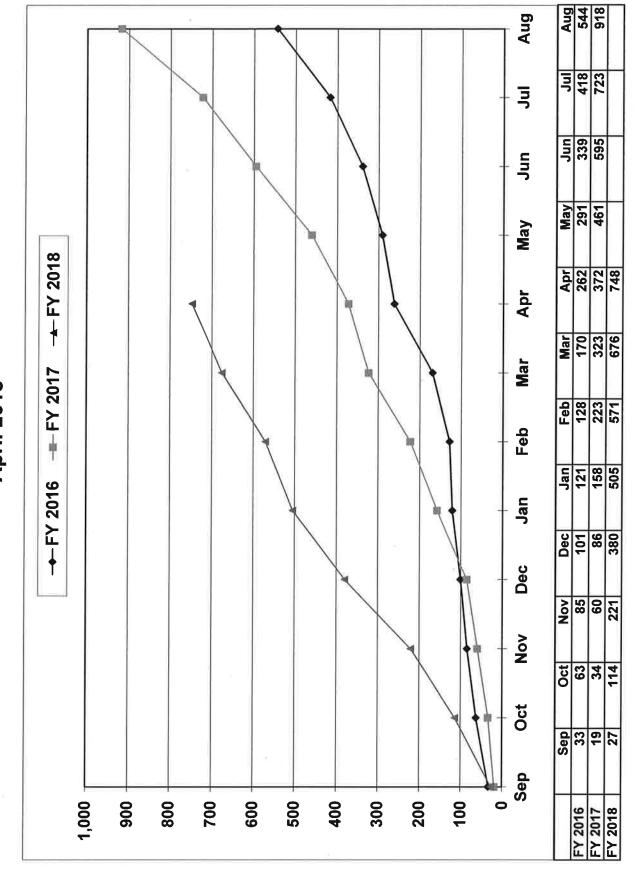

State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Cost of Wells Plugged April 2018

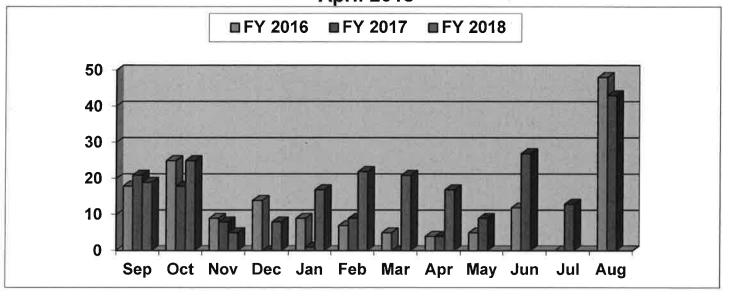

State-funded Well Plugging Program Cumulative Wells Plugged April 2018

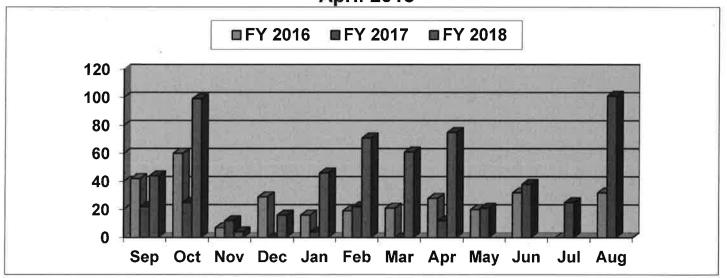


State-funded Well Plugging Program Monthly Salvage Operations April 2018



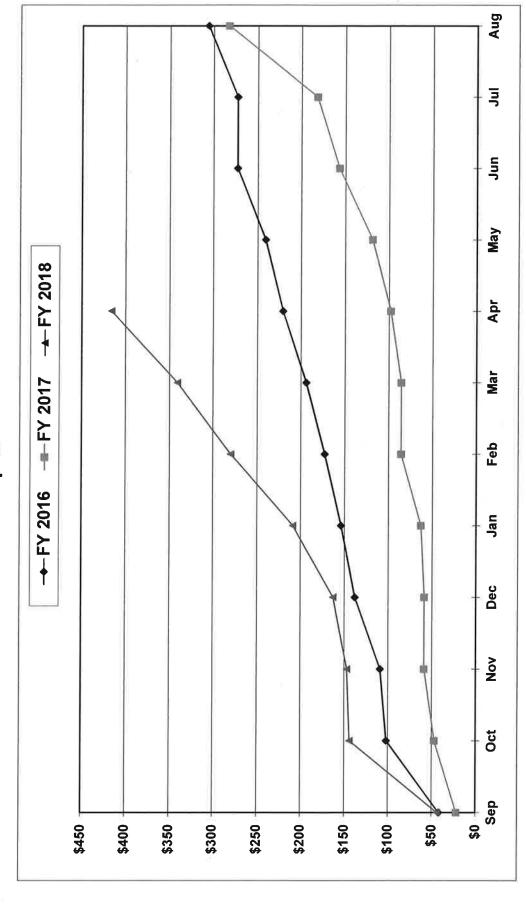
