**FINAL ORDER
GRANTING THE APPLICATION OF ELAND ENERGY, INC.
TO AMEND THE FIELD RULES FOR THE WICKETT (PENN.) FIELD,
WARD COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 15, 2017, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively, "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the field rules for the Wickett (Penn.) Field in Ward County, Texas are amended as follows:

The Wickett (Penn.) Field may be produced under a maximum efficient rate (MER) allowable of 250 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all accumulated overproduction for the Sealy Smith Lease, Well No. 845 (API No. 42-475-37112) is hereby canceled.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and by agreement of the Parties in writing or on the record, **the parties have waived right to file a Motion for Rehearing and this Final Order is effective on the date the Master Order relating to the Final Order is signed.**
