FINAL ORDER

**RESCINDING THE TEMPORARY FIELD RULES
AND RETURNING THE RULES TO STATEWIDE
FOR THE HARTLEY WEST (CANYON) FIELD
HARTLEY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Railroad Commission of Texas has reviewed the temporary field rules for the HARTLEY WEST (CANYON) Field, Hartley County, Texas. This review was performed on its own motion, following notice and opportunity for hearing pursuant to the Commission's Final Order in Oil & Gas Docket No. 10-0294348. Pursuant to this matter the Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

Findings of Fact

1. On May 12, 2015, in Oil & Gas Docket No. 10-0294348, the Commission amended the temporary field rules for the subject field. The field rules at that time included the following:
 - a. A correlative interval from 7,714 feet to 9,930 feet.
 - b. Lease line spacing of 330 feet and no between well spacing.
 - c. 160-acre standard proration units and 80 acres tolerance.
 - d. Common provisions for horizontal wells.
 - e. A two-factor allocation formula.
2. The temporary field rules were set to expire on July 15, 2016, but the Commission took no action at that time to alter the temporary field rules.
3. On July 7, 2016, the Commission notified all operators in the field that the subject field rules would be reviewed. All operators were given the opportunity to request a hearing, or indicate a position by the submittal of evidence, regarding Commission action on the temporary field rules.
4. On August 1, 2016, the Commission received a request from Continental Trend Resources, Inc., an operator in the field, requested the temporary field rules be continued




