ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Director of the Railroad Commission of Texas enters this order pursuant to Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 29, 2018, Luminant Energy Company, LLC ("Luminant"), filed a formal complaint against Energy Transfer Fuel, LP ("ETF"), a gas utility pipeline. The filing was docketed as GUD No. 10746.
2. On January 2, 2019, Luminant withdrew its complaint, without opposition.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal) authorizes the Hearings Director to dismiss a proceeding for just and reasonable reasons, including where a complainant withdraws the complaint.
2. Dismissal of this docket, per Luminant's request, is just and reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Luminant's complaint is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other motions, requests for entry of specific findings of fact and conclusions of law, and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not granted or approved in this Order, are hereby **DENIED**.
