ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Hearings Director of the Railroad Commission of Texas enters this Order pursuant to Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On May 14, 2018, Occidental Energy Marketing, Inc. ("OEMI"), filed a complaint against West Texas LPG Pipeline Limited Partnership ("WTXP"), alleging that WTXP unlawfully abandoned an existing connection. The filing was docketed as GUD No. 10732.
2. On February 6, 2019, OEMI withdrew its complaint, without opposition.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal) authorizes the Hearings Director to dismiss a proceeding for just and reasonable reasons, including where a complainant withdraws the complaint.
2. Dismissal of this docket, per OEMI's request, is just and reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that OEMI's complaint is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other motions, requests for entry of specific findings of fact and conclusions of law, and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not granted or approved in this Order, are hereby **DENIED**.
