Item #2: Please refer to Attachment 2 – Notes applicable to all Mandatory Pricing Sheets for the eight (8) Areas and all work under the Contract – item #12 for important changes relating to mob/demob:

Item #12 (a thru c) currently reads:

- a. For vacuum trucks and dump trucks, hourly rates shall be allowed yard to yard and for all on-site time as well as direct trips from the site to the disposal facility and direct return trips from the disposal facility to the site. Additional time, up to 15 minutes, may be allowed if applicable and necessary for compliance with USDOT-FMCSA required inspections of waste hauling vehicles, but only if incurred within the time frame immediately before or after a trip to or from the disposal facility for work required under the Contract. In such instances, Contractor may be required to provided documentary evidence of such inspections before RRC shall be required to pay for time claimed as attributable to such inspections.
- b. For equipment and personnel other than that referenced in paragraph 12.a. immediately above, hourly rates shall be allowed for mobilization time from and demobilization time to whichever of the following is least in time: Contractor's yard, overnight location of equipment and/or personnel, or such other location as deemed agreeable to RRC and Contractor within the signed Work Order.
- c. For subcontracted equipment and personnel other than that referenced in paragraph 12.a. immediately above, hourly rates shall be allowed for mobilization time from and demobilization time to whichever of the following is least in time: subcontractor's yard, overnight location of equipment and/or personnel, or such other location as deemed agreeable to RRC and Contractor within the signed Work Order.

Changes to these sections are highlighted, also (d) is added:

- a. For vacuum trucks and dump trucks, hourly rates shall be allowed yard to yard and for all on-site time as well as direct trips from the site to the disposal facility and direct return trips from the disposal facility to the site as long as the starting Mob and ending Demob of the waste hauling equipment is within district boundary lines, otherwise refer to conditions 12.b., 12.c. and 12.d. below. See map for district boundary lines. Additional time, up to 15 minutes, may be allowed if applicable and necessary for compliance with USDOT-FMCSA required inspections of waste hauling vehicles, but only if incurred within the time frame immediately before or after a trip to or from the disposal facility for work required under the Contract. In such instances, Contractor may be required to pay for time claimed as attributable to such inspections.
- b. For equipment and personnel other than that referenced in condition 12.a., hourly rates shall be allowed for mobilization time from and demobilization time to whichever of the following is least in travel time: The RRC District Office or the Contractor's yard. See map for District Office Locations.
- c. For subcontracted equipment and personnel other than that referenced in condition 12.a., hourly rates shall be allowed for mobilization time from and demobilization time to whichever of the following is least in travel time: The RRC District Office or the Subcontractor's yard. See map for District Office Locations.

d. Travel reimbursements for lodging and meals will be considered at the discretion of the RRC in circumstances where an overnight location promotes the timely and cost-effective completion of a multi-day Work Order clean-up.

All other aspects of the RFP# 455-18-8667 remain as is.
