ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Hearings Director of the Railroad Commission of Texas enters this Order pursuant to Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On November 21, 2017, Occidental Energy Marketing, Inc. ("OEMI"), filed a formal complaint against BridgeTex Pipeline Company, LLC ("BridgeTex"), alleging discrimination. The complaint was docketed as GUD No. 10675.
- 2. On February 19, 2019, OEMI withdrew its complaint and requested that it be dismissed with prejudice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Commission Rule § 1.107 (Dismissal) authorizes the Hearings Director to dismiss, with or without prejudice, a proceeding for just and reasonable reasons, including where a complainant withdraws the complaint.
- 2. Dismissal of this docket, per OEMI's request, is just and reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that OEMI's complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other motions, requests for entry of specific findings of fact and conclusions of law, and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not granted or approved in this Order, are hereby **DENIED**.
