APPLICATION OF TACTICAL OPERATING COMPANY, LLC (834365) PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 46 AND 36 FOR A PERMIT TO INJECT FLUID INTO A RESERVOIR PRODUCTIVE OF OIL AND GAS FOR THE MOSELEY, JOHNNIE UNIT 1 (091950) LEASE, WELL NO. 1, EUSTACE (SMACKOVER) FIELD, HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 26, 2018, the presiding Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas, subject to Tactical Operating Company, LLC obtaining an injection well permit pursuant to Statewide Rule 46 (16 Tex. Admin. Code § 3.46), Tactical Operating Company, LLC has met the requirements of Statewide Rule 36 and is hereby authorized to inject fluids containing hydrogen sulfide pursuant to Statewide Rule 36(c)(10)(A) for the the Moseley, Johnnie Unit 1 (091950) Lease, Well No. 1, Eustace (Smackover) Field, Henderson County, Texas. Tactical Operating Company, LLC's application for a permit pursuant to Statewide Rule 46 for the above-referenced well is **REMANDED** for administrative consideration.

Pursuant to § 2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and by agreement of the Parties in writing or on the record, **the parties have waived right to file a Motion for Rehearing and this Final Order is final and effective on the date the Master Order relating to the Final Order is signed.**
