Notice of Open Meeting to consider this Order was duly posted with the Secretary of State within the time provided by law pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE Chapter 551.

On April 16, 2019, Texas Gas Service, a Division of One Gas, Inc. ("TGS"), filed with the Railroad Commission a statement of intent to increase rates to recover Hurricane Harvey response costs within the Gulf Coast Service Area.

The Commission has the authority to suspend the proposed rates for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days from the date on which the rates otherwise would become effective, under Tex. UTIL. CODE § 104.107(a)(2). The Commission requires further time to consider the propriety of the proposed rate change.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS that the date on which TGS's proposed rate change would become effective is hereby **SUSPENDED** for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days.
