FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 14, 2019, the technical examiner and administrative law judge ("Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas on August 6, 2019.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Commission that all casinghead gas overproduction for the Lentz (11553) Lease, Well No. 1, in the Eloise (6430) Field ("Field"), Victoria County, Texas shall be cancelled.

Further, it is **ORDERED** by the Commission that the application of Acock/Anaqua Operating Co., LP for a net GOR for the Lentz (11553) Lease, Well No. 1, in the Eloise (6430) Field ("Field"), Victoria County, Texas, is hereby dismissed without prejudice due to the withdrawal of the application..

Pursuant to § 2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
