FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 1, 2019, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Ring Energy Inc. is hereby granted an increased daily casinghead limit of 2000 MCFPD and cancellation of overproduction for the Phoenix State (50540) Lease, Matthews (Brushy Canyon) Field, Culberson County, Texas.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the consent of the applicant, the Final Order is final and effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
