OVERPRODUCTION FOR THE JACK STATE A (51699) LEASE, TWO GEORGES
(BONE SPRING) FIELD, REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

FINAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission of Texas ("Commission") finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 8, 2019, the presiding technical examiner and administrative law judge ("Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation ("Report") containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application complies with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after consideration of this matter, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained in the Report and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

It is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all overproduction for the Jack State A (51699) Lease in the Two Georges (Bone Spring) Field (Field No. 92100050) in Reeves County, Texas is hereby cancelled through the effective date of this Final Order.

Pursuant to § 2001.144(a)(4)(A) of the Texas Government Code and the agreement of the parties in writing or on the record, **the parties have waived the right to file a motion for rehearing and the Final Order in this case is final and effective on the date the Master Order relating to the Final Order is signed.**
