**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EXXON MOBIL CORPORATION
TO BALANCE THE BLOCK 16 (DEVONIAN) FIELD
WARD COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 12, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.
