**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF ENDEAVOR ENERGY RESOURCES LP  
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 86  
FOR ITS WESTMINSTER UNIT, WELL NO. 1H  
NEWARK, EAST (BARNETT SHALE) FIELD  
DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 5, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Endeavor Energy Resources LP is hereby granted exception to Statewide Rule 86(d)(4) for its Westminster Unit, Well No. 1H, API No. 42-121-32422, in the Newark, East (Barnett Shale) Field, Denton County, Texas. This exception allows the penetration point for the subject well to be off-lease. The distance between perforations in the wellbore shall be used in the calculation of additional acreage assignment to the well, if applicable. The well shall be assigned an allowable, assuming all other required completion papers have been properly filed.
